Four Museums Route

- 1 Garage Museum of Contemporary Art
- 2 State Tretyakov Gallery and the New Tretyakov Gallery
- 3 The Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts
- 4 GES-2 is the Moscow building of the V-A-C Foundation, situated on the territory of a former power plant of the same name. It will open in 2020.

The cultural space in the city center, the equivalent of the New York Museum Mile, Berlin's Museum Island or the Vienna MuseumsQuartier, offers many options for leisure, from the rich heritage of world art to modern artistic practices. Walking or cycling along the embankments of the Moskva river can now become almost like an excursion, with many different opportunities available for the public.



Garage Museum of Contemporary Art

The main museum of modern art in Moscow is located in Gorky Park. The museum building, reconstructed by world-famous architect Rem Koolhaas, hosts exhibitions of world-famous Russian and foreign artists, as well as free lectures, master classes for visitors of all ages and events for visitors with disabilities. In Arts Square in summer you can watch films in the Garage Screen Pavilion and attend Mosaic Music concerts.


State Tretyakov Gallery and the New Tretyakov Gallery

The museum was founded by philanthropist Pavel Tretyakov in the 19th century. Having collected a vast collection of paintings by Russian artists in his estate, he opened it to the public. Later the gallery became owned by the state and now there is a huge collection of Russian fine art in its collection, from ancient Russian icons to the works of modernists.

The New Tretyakov Gallery is a branch of the Tretyakov Gallery situated on Krymskiy Val. In the New Tretyakov Gallery, paintings from the 20th and 21st centuries, created by Soviet and Russian artists, are on display. From Kandinsky and Shagall to the works of modern Russian artists, all of Russia's major art has been collected here in one place.

Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts

The Pushkin State Museum of Fine Arts is a museum complex which has one of the largest collections of foreign art in the whole of Russia. Today the collection contains about 700 thousand works from different eras: from ancient Egypt and ancient Greece to the beginning of the 21st century. The Gallery of European and American Art of the 19th and 20th centuries has one of the most famous collections of European modernism in the world.

How to get to the city from the airport

The most convenient way to get to Moscow from the Sheremetyevo, Domodedovo and Vnukovo airports is by the aerexpress high-speed rail link: aerexpress.ru.

At night you can travel to the city by bus:

You can also take commuter trains, other buses, minibuses and regular taxis.

Carsharing

Moscow carsharing is convenient and inexpensive.

Download the operator's application on your smartphone, register, attach photos of documents (passport, driving license) and wait for confirmation of registration.

The largest car sharing companies are **Yandex.Drive**, **YouDrive**, **BelkaCar**, **MatreshCar** and **Delimobil**.

Bikesharing

You don't have to walk or use public transport to get around Moscow — you can rent a bike.

You can register yourself in the bike rental system either using the Velobike application, at a station terminal or at velobike.ru.

You pay for your rental with a card and off you go! Trips for up to 30 minutes are free and bikes can be taken from one station and returned to any other.

Points of Interest

Kremlin

The Kremlin is an ancient fortress situated in the center of Moscow. See the Kremlin walls and towers, the famous cathedrals in Cathedral Square and visit the museums, including the Armory and the Patriarch's Chamber. Stroll through Red Square and admire St. Basil's Cathedral.

Zaryadye Park

Zaryadye Park is an innovative cultural and educational center near the Red Square. In the park you can see a unique botanical collection from some of the various different natural zones of Russia and visit the Polet flying cinema, the Time Machine 360 panorama, the exhibition hall, the Ice Cave, the Florarium scientific and educational center and greenhouse complex, the underground interactive museum, the Large Amphitheatre and the Concert Hall and the best observation deck in the city — the floating bridge — which offers scenic views of the historical center of Moscow.

Gorky Park

Gorky Park is one of the most fashionable open spaces in the city. Here you can not only walk and relax, but also do sports and activities. The park has special tracks for cycling and rollerskating as well as badminton and beach volleyball courts. In summer you can go out on the water in boats, and on pedalos, in winter you can go ice skating. The park has a huge playground for children with unusual and original games and attractions.

MAMM Multimedia Art Museum

MAMM specialises in photography. Here you can find a permanent exhibition on display, but in addition to this there are regular temporary exhibitions. Every year the museum organises large-scale biennales. On odd years there is a photobiennale and on even years there is the "Fashion and style in photography" biennale. The Museum houses and supports The Alexander Rodchenko School of Photography and Multimedia.

VDNH & The Space Pavilion

At VDNH you can learn about the USSR and some of its most interesting aspects. VDNH (Exhibition of Achievements of National Economy) is a giant exhibition complex which was built in 1939. Here you can explore Soviet architecture and sculptures, visit one of the many museums, go rollerblading or cycling or just walk around. Be sure to visit the Space pavilion. This is one of the most attractive pavilions of the VDNH complex. There is now a Cosmonautics and Aviation center situated inside it.

The Seven Sisters

Stalin's seven skyscrapers, known as the Seven Sisters, were intended as a symbol of the restoration of the capital of the USSR after the Second World War. These monumental buildings are still significant for the country.

11 The tallest of the seven buildings is the main building of Moscow State University, which is situated on Vorobyovy Gory.

Moscow Zoo

The Moscow Zoo, founded in 1864, is one of the oldest zoos in Europe. It is located on a 21 hectare area in the center of the capital. The animals in the zoo are provided with comfortable conditions, as close as possible to their natural habitats. Here you can see capybaras, meerkats, Pallas's cats and other animals, as well as learn more about them and their habitat.

Moscow City

Moscow City (Moscow International Business Center) is a business development situated in the west of the capital. The quarter naturally fits into the architectural image of the city, and today Moscow can no longer be imagined without it. PANORAMA 360, Europe's highest observation deck, is situated on the 89th floor of the Federation Tower. The area offers an impressive view over the metropolis.

Jewish Museum and Tolerance Center

This is the most technologically advanced museum in Moscow. It allows visitors to get acquainted with the history of the Jewish people in there an interactive way. The activity of the museum is aimed at studying Jewish culture and their religious traditions. The museum has an educational and research center, as well as the Avant-Garde Center, which conducts educational lectures and seminars on art and culture from 1910-1930s.

Tsaritsyno Park and Royal Estate

Catherine II, who bought Tsaritsyno and ordered a palace complex to be built there, did not actually settle in her new estate. Some of the buildings have been preserved to this day and have been reconstructed. Now Tsaritsyno is one of the most beautiful parks in Moscow. Both residents and guests of the capital love to go and relax there.
